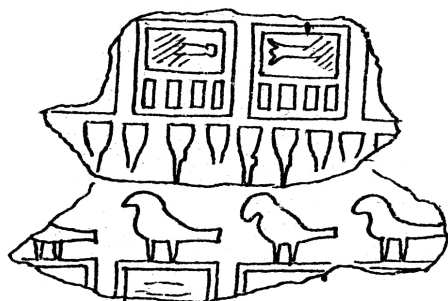

Kaplony's UC 1 = UC35687; Kaplony's UC 2 = UC35688

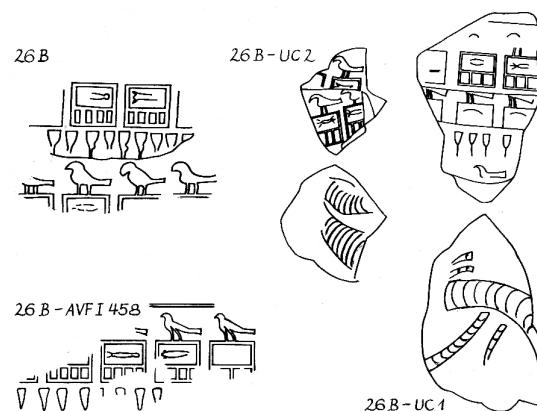
